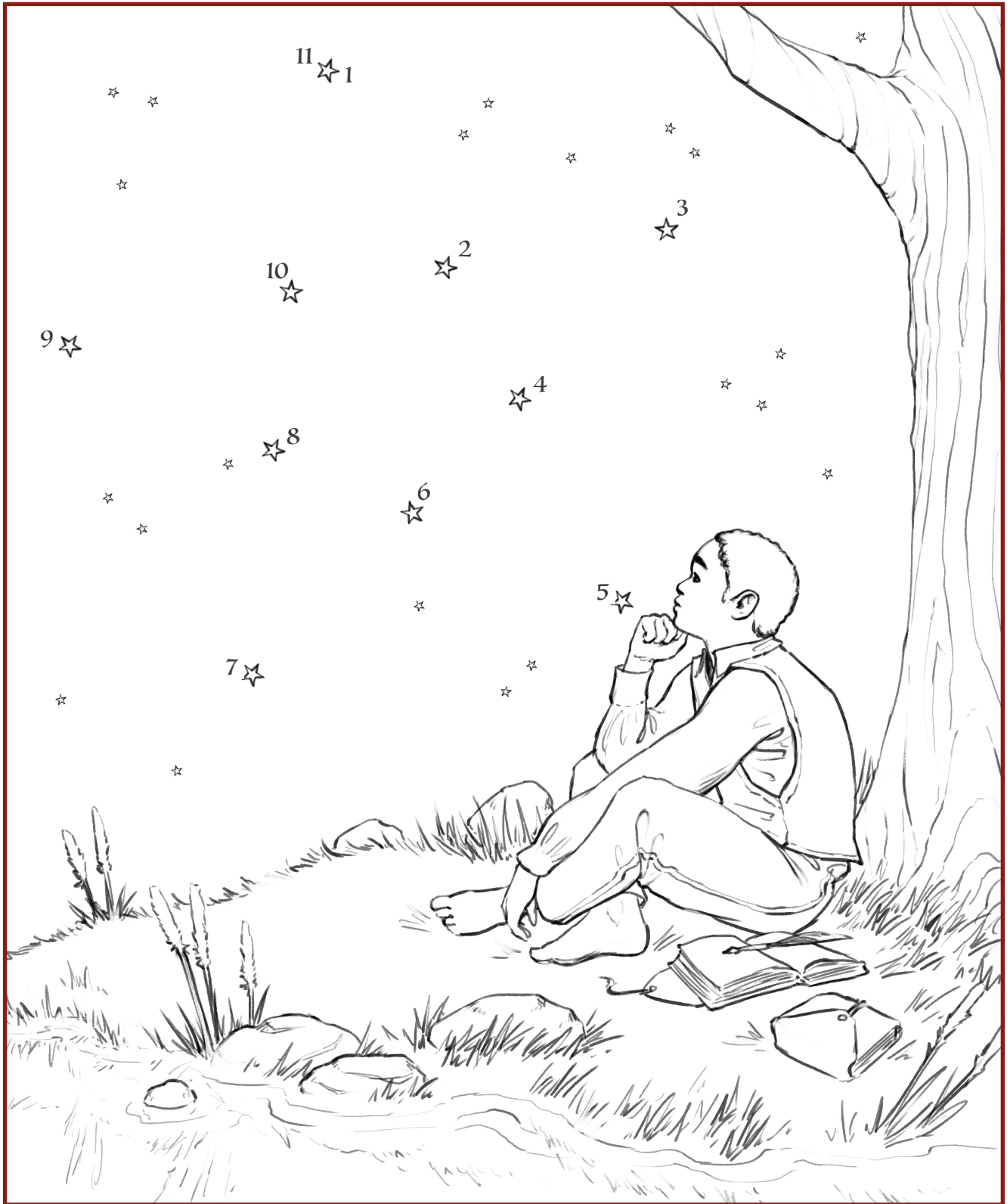




CONNECT THE STARS

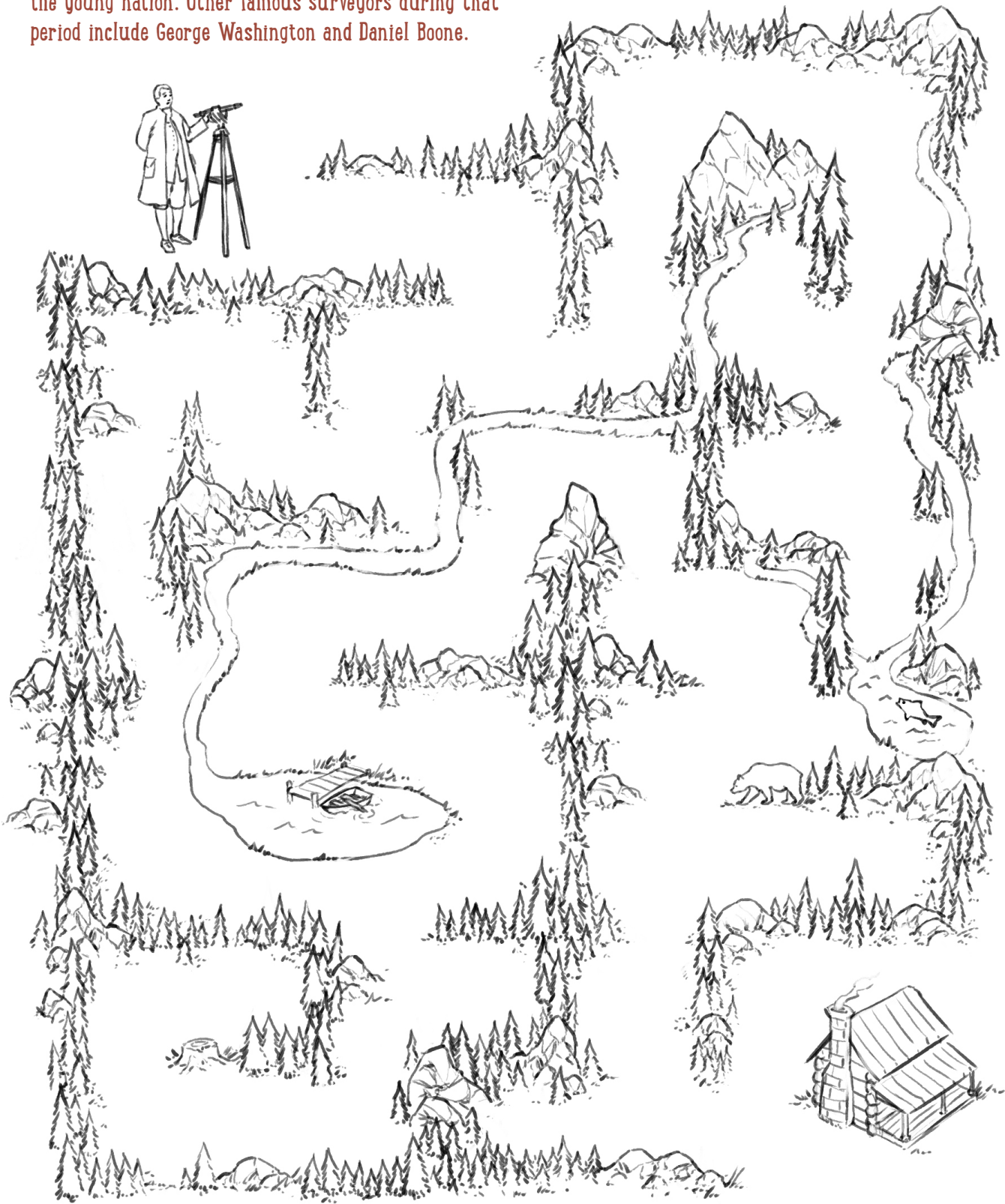
