says Mack.



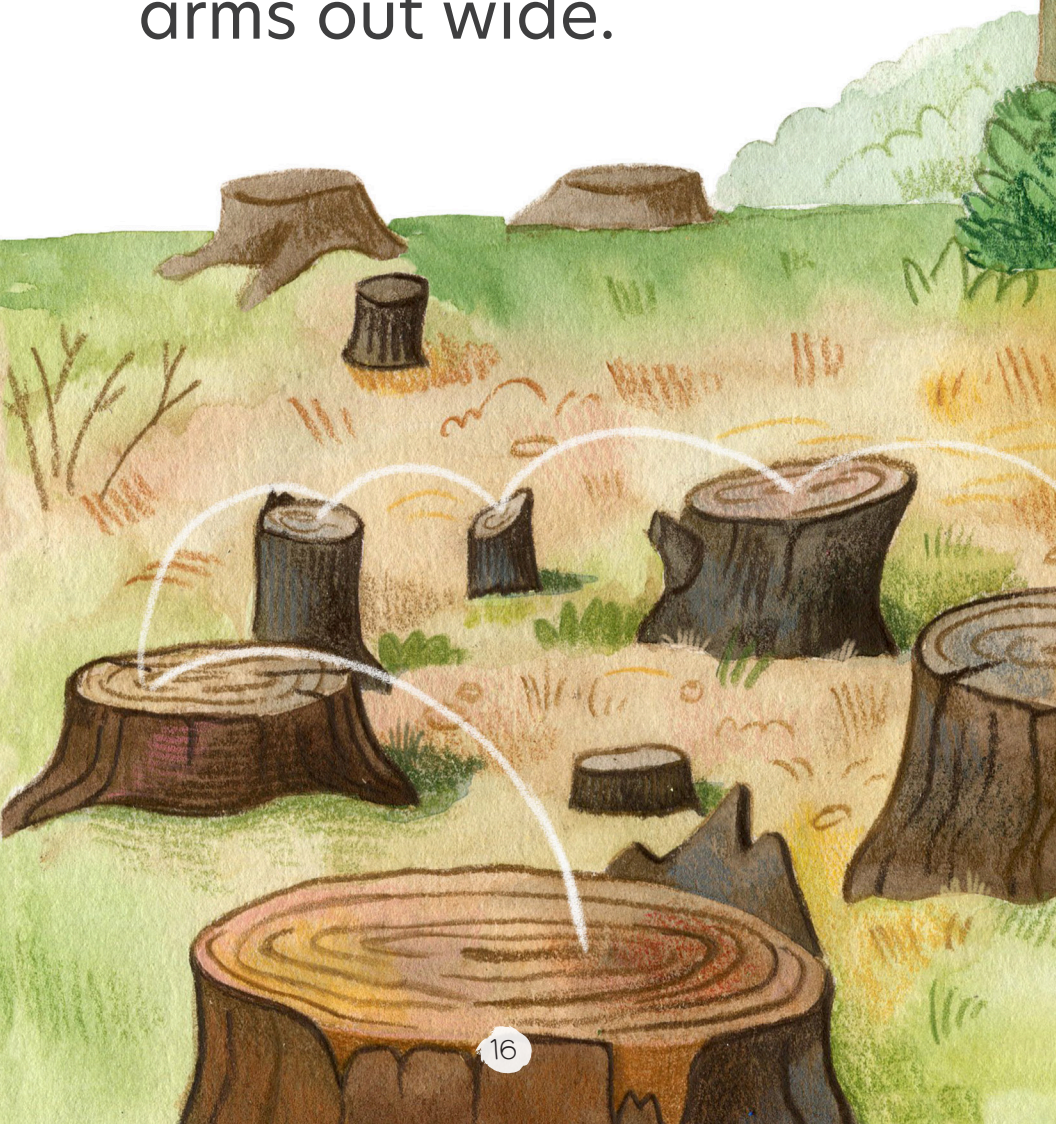


“I wish I could fly,” yells Ed. He jumps up and runs so his cape goes out.

“Stop!”





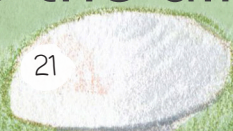
Mack and Will run to
